

Lodging Tax Facts:

It's Paid by Visitors, Not Residents

The lodging tax is collected primarily from overnight visitors staying in hotels, motels, vacation rentals, or campgrounds.

Reduces the Tax Burden on Residents

Tourism revenue, supported by lodging tax, helps offset local taxes that would otherwise need to fund amenities and infrastructure. Visitors essentially help "pay their share" for using roads, parks, and services.
