ROYAL GORGE BRIDGE & PARK

The Royal Gorge Bridge & Park is one of Colorado's iconic and must-see attractions. Known as America's Bridge located in the heart of the Royal Gorge Region, visitors can walk across one of the world's highest suspension bridges and take in pure Colorado fun and scenery.



Royal Gorge Bridge

Not only can visitors enjoy the breathtaking scenery from above the gorge, they can now climb the steep walls on the Royal Gorge Via Ferrata. This attraction is a protected and safe climbing system on the sheer vertical walls of the Royal Gorge, using trained guides, climbing harnesses with carabiners, steel cables, and iron rungs installed into the rock surfaces. Routes 400-600 feet into the gorge can accommodate beginners to advanced climbers. This is a perfect family outing for an unforgettable experience. The Royal Gorge Via Ferrata is suitable for ages 10 and up. (Extra pay feature, reservations required.)

Other world-class attractions include the aerial gondolas traversing 2,400 feet across the gorge and Tommy Knocker Playland, a children's play area, featuring a beautifully crafted carousel and climbing structures. Kids will enjoy the splash pad, Musket Mine and sluice box during the summer months.

For the daring, the Royal Gorge Cloudscraper by ZipRider flies guests 1,000 feet over the river, and patrons can experience the World's Scariest Skycoaster sitting on the very edge of the gorge. Both are extra pay features and open mid-March to end of December (weather permitting.)

The Royal Gorge Bridge & Park is open all year! Visit in the winter to enjoy a wonderland above the Arkansas River.

Aerial Gondola

The park, including the Bridge and Visitor Center, is open 365 days a year. The Visitor Center, with its mammoth deck overlooking the gorge, is the perfect place to shop, dine, or just relax and enjoy the surroundings.

The park has a storied history beginning with the spectacular undertaking of building the Royal Gorge Bridge in 1929, and is the highest suspension bridge in America to date. The bridge survived a

wildfire in 2013 and sustained only minimal damage while 90% of the park was destroyed. The rebuild was a spectacular undertaking. Visit the Plaza Theater and Historical Expo for the whole story!

Rafting the Royal Gorge

From whitewater rafting to cooling off at the park, the Arkansas River offers something for all ages and abilities. Dip your toes in the water or head out with an experienced commercial guide - the options are endless!

Mild

Upper Bighorn Sheep Canyon is not only home to Gold Medal Fishing waters, but is also a scenic alternative for those who would like a more relaxing trip on the river. With smaller rapids suitable for families and first-time rafters, this section, located in western Fremont County, is a great way to experience the river.



WHITEWATER KAYAK AND RECREATION PARK / PLAYWAVE

Bring your surf, paddle, or boogie board and take a spin on the playwaves at Centennial Park! Specially designed static waves allow beginners and advanced boarders to practice, play, and enjoy a day at the river. Nearby playground facilities, restrooms, and a splash pad make for a full day of fun.

FISHING

There are plenty of opportunities throughout the year to fish along the Arkansas' Gold Medal fishing waters. Catch the Caddis hatch in the spring and fly fish in the fall. Learn how by hiring a guide to help you in your search for "the big one".



Water Levels: Water tends to be higher in the spring and runs low and slow in late-summer through winter.



CENTENNIAL PARK

When the spring runoff recedes in mid-summer, there's plenty of opportunity to take a dip in the river to cool off. Splash around near the water's edge where it's shallow and calm. Please note that Colorado law requires that all persons under the age of 13 swimming in the Arkansas River must wear a personal flotation device (life jacket). You can borrow one from the loaner station at the park, but please return it!

BIGHORN SHEEP CANYON

For fun, splashy whitewater and beautiful views of the mountains surrounding the Royal Gorge Region, head to Bighorn Sheep Canyon. Try to spot one of the namesake animals and splash through rapids on this family-friendly section. Those without experience navigating rapids should not attempt Bighorn Sheep Canyon: trust a commercial guide service in the area.



KEEP IT GORGEOUS

Be aware of changing water levels and conditions. Always wear a life jacket (personal flotation device) when recreating in the river!



Wild

ROYAL GORGE

If thrills, coupled with some of the most incredible scenery in Colorado, are what you're looking for, there's no better place to be than the Royal Gorge. Experience intermediate and advanced (Class III-V) rapids while floating underneath the famed Royal Gorge Bridge. Towering almost 1,000 feet above your head, the walls of the Gorge offer stunning sights and heart-pumping whitewater. Commercial guide services are the best way to experience these rapids - which should NOT be attempted by amateurs.

Raft Trips & Packages in the Royal Gorge

For the best summer ride in Colorado plan on getting wet and enjoying some of the Royal Gorge Region's world-famous attractions with Raft Masters in Cañon City, only 45 miles southwest of Colorado Springs.

Whether it's the relaxing sound of flowing water, the scenery, or the mild-to-wild thrill of world-class whitewater, the Arkansas River draws people from around the world to Raft Masters in the Royal Gorge region. With rapids that range from Class I to Class V there's a trip for everyone.

There is no better way experience the Royal Gorge Region than from the river itself. When deciding how to choose a raft trip, Raft Masters suggests choosing a trip based on the level of difficulty, the ages of the participants (particularly children), your physical condition, length of trip and the type of raft (paddle or paddle assist) you prefer.

It is also recommended to ask an outfitter how long they have been in business (with the current owners), the trips they run, as well as any additional costs you might expect such as rental fees for additional equipment like wetsuits and boots.

Whitewater rafting trips are available at Raft Masters from March through October. Water levels fluctuate throughout this period, so depending on what type of experience you're looking for you should plan accordingly.

Do you want the biggest waves and wettest rides? Then late May through June is best, when water levels are at their peak. In July water and air temperatures are rising and water levels are moderating, making for ideal rafting conditions. July is also the busiest month of the Colorado rafting season, and weekdays are generally less busy than weekends.

August is warm and dry with lower water levels that are challenging due to the technical difficulty of the lower flows. Early and late season trips are uncrowded and relaxing-paced.

Do you want to do more than raft? Leave the planning to Raft Masters and experience Full-Day packages that combine a half day of rafting with other exceptional area attractions. Packages include Colorado Jeep Tours, the Royal Gorge Railroad, the Royal Gorge Bridge & Park, zip lining, ATV tours, and more.

HIT THE TRAILS

Hiking and Biking the Royal Gorge Region

Add some adventure to your visit by heading out on the Royal Gorge Region's trails. From challenging singletrack bike rides to quiet riverside strolls, you'll find something for everyone in the area. Unique geology, wildlife, wildflowers, and stunning views await!

Point Alta Vista

ROYAL GORGE PARK

The Canyon Rim Trail, Elk Horn Loop, and Point Alta Vista (shown above), offer breathtaking views and are appropriate for varied abilities. Trails range from relatively easy to advanced. The Canyon Rim Trail, including Elk Horn Loop, offers up breathtaking views, but be aware of exposed areas. East Ridge Campground connects to a multitude of trails, including S'Mores – a popular option for young bikers.



ARKANSAS RIVERWALK TRAIL

The Riverwalk Trail runs through some of the most scenic parts of Cañon City. Along the 7-mile stretch of trail, you'll track the river's course through the city, passing farmland, cottonwood groves, and city parks. The Riverwalk Trail is mostly a flat, maintained trail that is open during all seasons-perfect for families and cruiser bike rides. Don't miss the historic tunnels on Tunnel Drive at the western most end of the trail. Tunnels are located 0.25 miles from the trailhead.



SOUTH CAÑON TRAILS

From the Eagle Wing Trailhead near the Riverwalk, try Mutton Bustin' for an easy ride or walk. Those looking for a challenge (and inspiring views) can head up Hard Time to The Great Escape. This trail system connects to Cañon City's B.F. Rockafellar Park, commonly known as Ecology Park – a popular hiking destination.



OIL WELL FLATS

One of the most popular and extensive trail systems in the area, Oil Well Flats includes 12 miles of singletrack trails. Cruise through high desert as you ascend Unconformity or Fire Canyon toward Island in the Sky for spectacular views of Cañon City and beyond to the Wet Mountains and the Sangre de Cristo range.

MOUNTAIN BIKE ITINERARY

DAY 1

MORNING:

- Have a camp breakfast at your campsite at East Ridge Campground
- Drive to the Royal Gorge Trails to enjoy 22+ miles of fun

LUNCH/AFTERNOON:

- Head to a restaurant near the Gorge to fuel up with a beverage and a burger

DINNER/EVENING:

- Take a leisurely stroll out to Point Alta Vista to watch the sunset

DAY 2

MORNING:

- Breakfast at a local coffee shop for a breakfast burrito
- Ride from downtown to start your ride at Eagle Wing Trailhead at South Canyon Trails (see joinFAR.org for routes)

LUNCH/AFTERNOON:

- Downtown restaurants are open for beverages and delicious food - take advantage!

DINNER/EVENING:

- Spend some time checking out local art and murals. Bonus if it's a "First Friday" and plenty of shops are open late

DAY 3

MORNING:

- Camp breakfast supplemented with coffee from downtown on your way to Oil Well Flats. Enjoy miles of trail and 'top out' at Island in the Sky

LUNCH/AFTERNOON:

- On your way back to your campsite, call in a delicious pizza or meatball sub from downtown and take it up

DINNER/EVENING:

- Relax your legs, and take a short stroll from your campsite to 'Le View' to watch the sun set over the Sangres

ROYAL GORGE VIA FERRATA

No experience is necessary for this exciting, scenic, and world-class climbing adventure. Your guide will outfit you with all of the gear necessary to descend into the famed Royal Gorge and traverse cliff faces. Choose the adventure length that is right for your group – from 2.5-5 hours. Must be 10 years old to participate.

ZIPLINE

Whether you'd like to soar across the 1,000-foot Royal Gorge or spend an afternoon zipping around the Royal Gorge hills, the Royal Gorge Region has plenty of options. Zipping over tree tops or canyons will leave you with memories to last a lifetime.



Shelf Road Climbing Area

SKYLINE DRIVE

This one-way road, built in 1905 by prison labor, is 2.5 miles long and soars above Cañon City. Take note of dinosaur tracks near the top, and note the archway at the beginning of the road. Take note of vehicle and weather restrictions.



POINT ALTA VISTA TRESTLES

Point Alta Vista scenic viewpoint was a family favorite in the 1980's, allowing visitors to peer into the Royal Gorge from a viewpoint accessed by a miniature train. Now, the trestles are accessible by foot or bike via public trails at the Royal Gorge Trails. See www.joinFAR.org or the COTREX app for more information on trailheads, difficulty level, and distances.

ROCK CLIMBING

The Royal Gorge Region is no stranger to rock climbing. Boasting one of Colorado's largest sport climbing destinations, Shelf Road, the region is a year-round destination for rock climbers. With a wealth of cliff options at Shelf Road, you will find plenty of sunny or shady climbing areas at most of the climbing sites.

ATV/Four-Wheeling

The Royal Gorge Region has some of the best trails in Colorado for ATV and 4-wheel fun at the Texas Creek Recreation Area.

Clearance varies on these routes, and the network links some ATV sections with 4-wheel drive. There are miles and miles of trails and tracks. Among the most popular 4-wheel drive routes are Bull Gulch (606), Fremont County Road 27 (27), Fernleaf Gulch Connector (6020) and Reese Gulch Bypass (6024). Popular with ATVers are East Arkansas River Overlook (6025), Cut Off (6036) and Tucker Trail (6035).

Always consult maps, check weather forecast in advance; and be aware of the BLM regulations. The Royal Gorge Region also has several guide services – a great idea for novice riders or folks unfamiliar with Rocky Mountain terrain. The BLM/USFS regional office is located at 3028 E. Main Street, Cañon City.

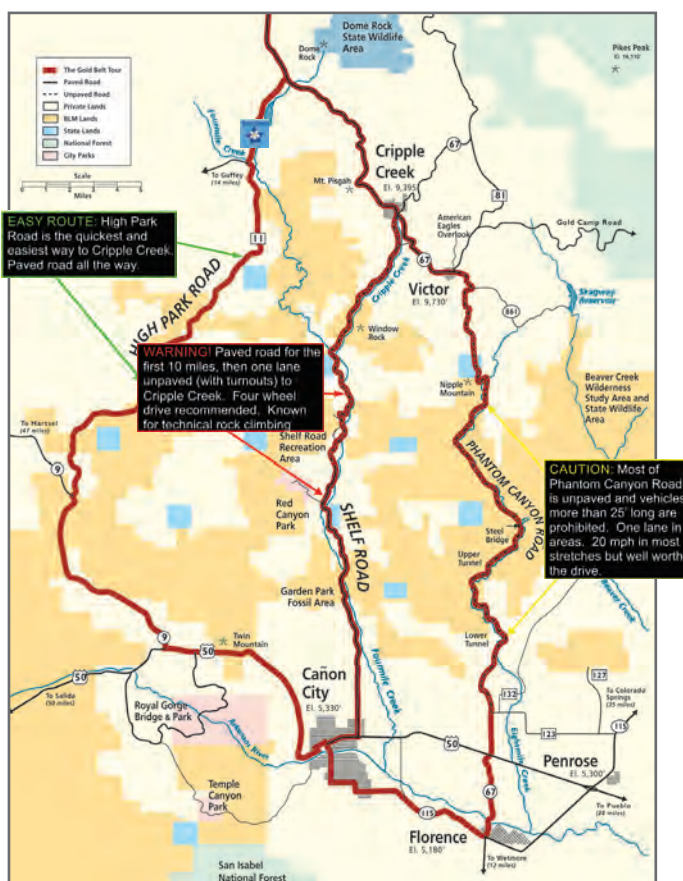




HIGH PARK ROAD

West of Cañon City to CO. 9. North on Hwy 9 for eight miles to High Park Road. East on High Park Road.

All roads lead to historic Cripple Creek and Victor. In its glory days Cripple Creek boasted two opera houses, 75 saloons, 8 newspapers and a stock exchange. Limited stakes gaming has revitalized the town with casinos, shops and restaurants, while maintaining its heritage. Cripple Creek even has its own donkey herd, descendants of the animals that once worked in the mines. Learn mining history and walk the Vindicator Valley trail in nearby Victor.

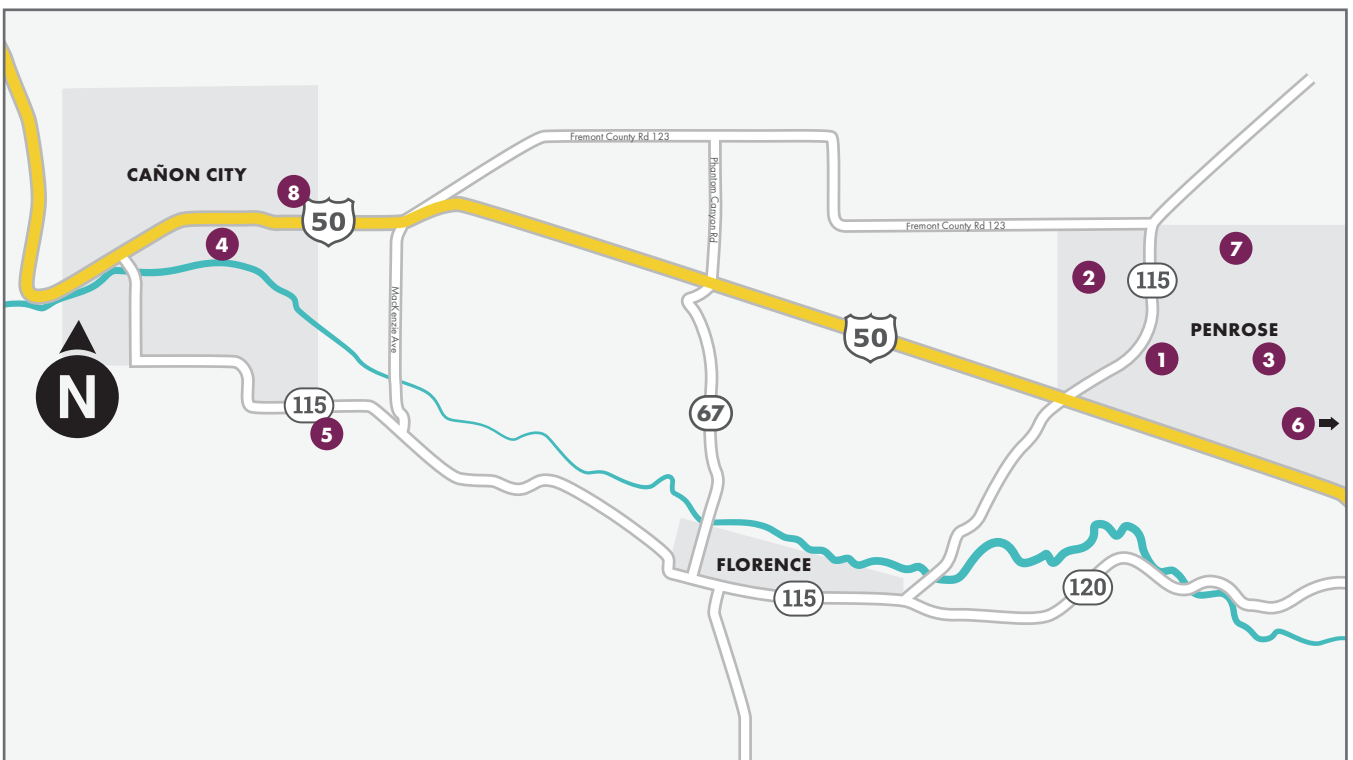

GEOLOGY

DINOSAUR & FOSSIL FINDS

View prehistoric tracks, walk discovery trails, search for fossils (never disturb or remove fossils). Visit the Royal Gorge Regional History Museum to see an outstanding display of fossils, dinosaur bones, and a complete Stegosaurus replica skeleton displayed as it was found in the ground in 1992.



These tracks on Skyline Drive were made by dinosaurs walking along the seaway 107 million years ago!



ROYAL GORGE DINOSAUR EXPERIENCE

The Royal Gorge Dinosaur Experience provides an affordable, dynamic and high-value educational opportunity for people of all ages. The state-of-the-art, 16,200 square-foot building houses a world-class collection of interactive displays, full-scale dinosaur fossil casts, real dinosaur fossils. Entertaining guided tours of our exhibit halls, and outdoor skinned animatronic dinosaur exhibits and a multi-story ropes course to ensure a fine balance between science, learning, and good old-fashioned family fun. GARDEN PARK FOSSIL AREA

Garden Park Fossil Area, located just north of Cañon City on Red Canyon Road, is a 2,700 acre-area that has produced significant dinosaur fossils for over 140 years. Some of the Jurassic fossils from this area are now at the Smithsonian National Museum of Natural History and the Peabody Museum at Yale University. Three stegosaurus skeletons, including Colorado's state fossil were excavated here. It now features interpretive markers and trails. www.HandsOnTheLand.org/garden-park

INDIAN SPRINGS TRACE FOSSIL SITE

This privately-owned Thorson Family Ranch is designated by the National Park Service as a National Natural Landmark. Fishing, Wildlife & Bird Watching

The Royal Gorge Region and its lands are home to an amazing variety of wildlife viewing opportunities. Keep your eyes open for **deer, bighorn sheep, pronghorn antelope, elk, bear, eagles** and other birds of prey.

Grab your binoculars and a field guide for some of the best bird watching in Colorado. Bird watchers will want to check out the large blue heron populations along County Road 69 and also along the Arkansas River. Buntings, Eagles, Kittiwakes, Goshawk, Kestrel, Woodpeckers, and Yellowthroat are also common in the region.

Cañon City's Riverwalk Trail follows the Arkansas River for more than seven miles, winding through wetlands, groves of cottonwoods and the parks. An early morning or evening stroll along the Riverwalk Trail provides great opportunities for bird watching and wildlife spotting.

GOLD MEDAL FLY FISHING

The **Arkansas River** is the longest Gold Medal River in North America, and attracts anglers from all over the world. With some of the highest trout densities of any freshwater watershed in the world, anglers can expect to see trophy-sized **Brown Trout, Rainbow Trout** and even the occasional **Cutthroat**. The Arkansas River is also known as a renowned dry fly fishery with large hatches from March through October.

The Arkansas River and surrounding drainages are year-round fisheries, however, anglers begin to flock to this area during the famed **Caddis Hatch** which begins the first week of April. This hatch begins in Cañon City and moves to the headwater near Leadville over the course of several months. However, July through September can offer some of the best productivity of the year with heavy hatches and overall favorable conditions to wade or float the river.



Autumn on the Arkansas: Fly fishing in the fall brings a wealth of beauty and solace. Find a secluded spot along the river while the cottonwood trees change colors in September and October.

RIVER RECREATION

Rafts and kayaks of every size float the beautiful **Arkansas River** from spring through summer and even into early fall. Some anglers fish from rafts and enjoy a thrilling ride through the rapids from Texas Creek to Parkdale and even through the gorge! A recreational raft trip is a good way to enjoy the river when the flows may be too swift for quality fishing. Check with local outfitters for guided fishing or rafting trips on the Arkansas River.



ARTS & CULTURE

First-time visitors are immediately struck by the mild climate and the breathtaking natural beauty of the Royal Gorge Region, but often it's the rich artistic expression and cultural diversity that brings people back.

THE FREMONT CENTER FOR THE ARTS

This public art gallery was founded in 1947 and is housed in the city's former post office building. Recently renovated and now offering a wealth of events and classes, FCA is the heart of the historic downtown area. Stop in to view the most recent exhibit, which often includes dozens of local artists and opportunities, and to see FCA's stunning building and permanent collection.

BELL TOWER CULTURAL CENTER

Stop in for a wide array of events throughout the year, including a monthly jazz series, monthly art exhibits, and classes for all ages. Space is available for weddings and meetings. Find more information at florenceartscouncil.com, via Facebook, or at 719-784-2038.

MUSEUM OF COLORADO PRISONS

This unique museum is located next door to the historic Colorado Territorial Correctional Facility, the oldest prison west of the Mississippi, opened in 1871. The museum is housed in the former Women's Correctional Facility and contains 30-plus cells, now converted into exhibits that give visitors a glimpse into the life of former inmates. From confiscated contraband to inmate arts and crafts, peruse the many artifacts and records. An audio tour and self-guided booklets are available in four languages. The museum is open during the summer, Monday through Sunday, 10 am - 6 pm, and during the winter, Wednesday through Sunday, 10 am - 5 pm.

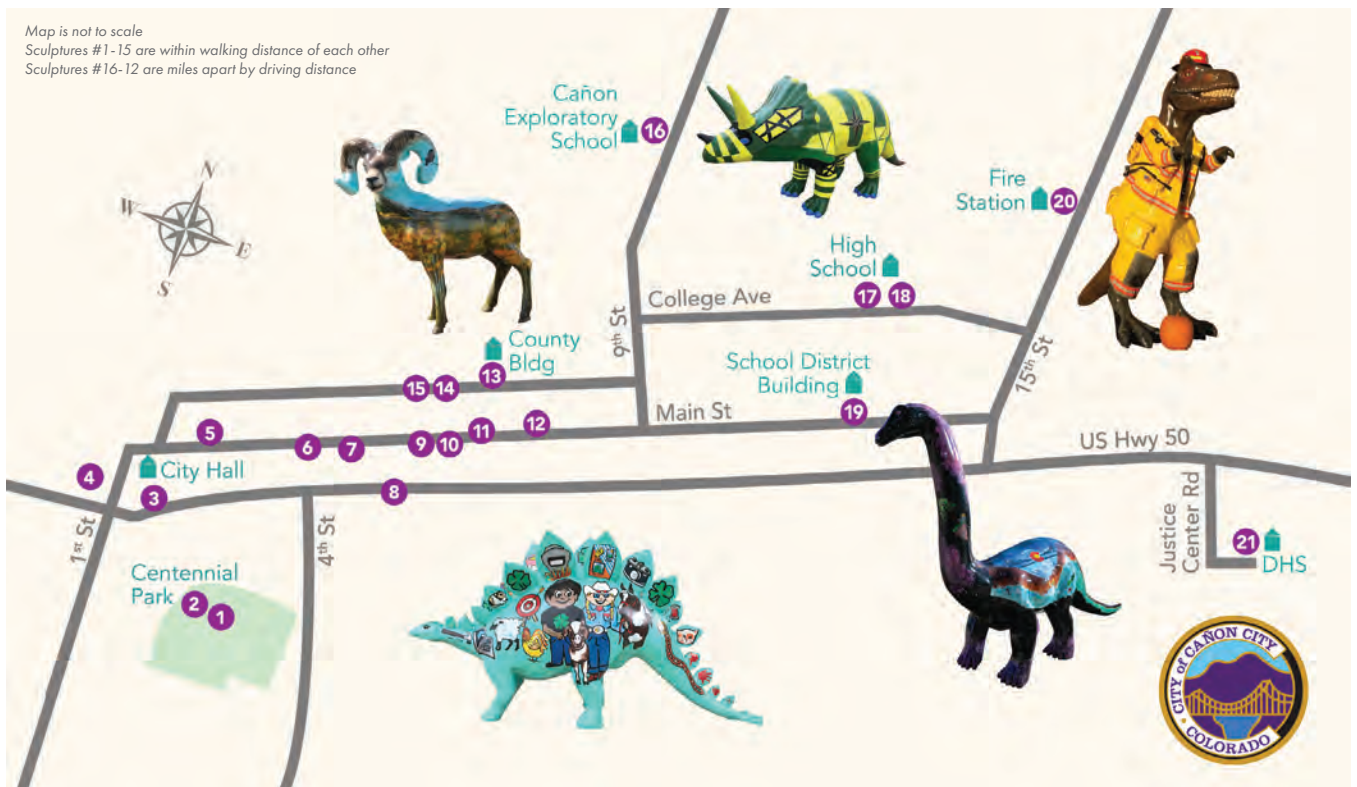


THE ROYAL GORGE REGIONAL MUSEUM & HISTORY CENTER

The premier research facility for local historians, the museum is conveniently located just off Highway 50 and is free to visit. 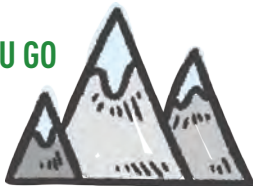

LEAVE NO TRACE – CARE FOR COLORADO PRINCIPLES

01 KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- This land really *is* your land. Our state and federal agencies manage 42 percent of Colorado's majestic landscape, and our cities and counties maintain even more. Learn about and respect the spaces we all own, share and sing about.
- Stay back from the pack. Find your way to less-visited and off-peak destinations to minimize down time and maximize your connection with special places.
- Bring along reusable water bottles or hot drink tumblers to limit waste and stay hydrated in our dry climate.



02 STICK TO TRAILS

- With 39,000 marked trails and 13,000 designated campsites, there's no need to venture beyond. By sticking to these areas and camping at least 200 feet from lakes, rivers and streams, you're helping natural areas stay natural.
- Even though shortcuts can be tempting, please don't take them. A few extra strides on the path will protect plants and the homes of the true locals.



03 LEAVE IT AS YOU FIND IT

- Leave plants, rocks and historical items as you find them so others experience the joy of discovery.
- Any of our 750 different species of wildflowers will live forever in a photo. Snap away, but only with a camera.
- Colorado is beautiful all on its own. Building structures or campsites on public land isn't cool. Keep it pristine for everyone to enjoy.
- Treat all living things with respect. Carving or hacking plants and trees may kill or disfigure them.



04 TRASH THE TRASH

- Pack it in, pack it out. Or pick it up to leave a place better than you found it. Put litter, even crumbs, peels and cores in your nearest waste/recycling bin.
- Wash yourself, your dog or whatever else needs cleaning at least 200 feet from waterways, and use biodegradable soap. A bubble bath is no treat for fish.



05 BE CAREFUL WITH FIRE

- Colorado's low humidity has perks, but can create dry, dangerous conditions. Keep campfires small and manageable to avoid sparking wildfires.
- When putting out a fire, water it until you can handle the embers. Never let a fire burn unattended.
- Use care when smoking in Colorado's dry climate. Always put cigarettes out completely, and don't leave your butts behind.
- Always check for local fire restrictions.



06 KEEP WILDLIFE WILD

- Colorado is home to tens of thousands of furry, scaly and feathered creatures. To keep them – and you – safe, don't approach them.
- It is not adorable to feed wild animals. You could alter natural behaviors, exposing them to predators or even euthanasia.
- Keep your furry buddies leashed when enjoying dog-friendly trails, and pack out their waste. All the way to a trashcan.



07 SHARE OUR TRAILS & PARKS

- Chances are you're not out in nature to people watch, so try out the lesser-known paths and sites.
- Silence your cell phone before stepping into nature, and speak softly without using the speaker function.
- Be considerate when passing others on the trails and yield to the uphill hiker and biker – they need the momentum.
- Listen to nature. Keep your voice and music soft so all can enjoy the peace of Colorado.

HEAT EXHAUSTION/STROKE

Dress in layers for varying weather; wear sunglasses and sunscreen. If you feel fatigue, nausea, headache, excessive thirst, rapid heartbeat, muscle cramps, etc., get to air conditioning or a shady area then rest, drink water, and apply ice towels. Get medical care immediately; delay of severe cases can be fatal.

SNAKE BITES

The hospital carries anti-venom medication. Get medical care immediately; delay could lead to loss of limb or death.

ALTITUDE SICKNESS

For headache, no appetite, nausea/vomiting, weakness, dizziness, etc., go to lower altitude, rest, drink water, and take medication for headache. If symptoms worsen, get medical care immediately.

ORTHOPEDIC INJURY

For foot/ankle injury, use shoe as stabilizer; for broken bones, stabilize, ice, and elevate; take anti-inflammatory medication; needs timely evaluation. If open fracture, get medical care immediately to avoid infection.

The Arkansas River Headwaters Recreation Area, managed by Colorado Parks & Wildlife, maintains several recreation sites for rafting, fishing, reserved camping and picnicking along the way; each have toilets. Make use of the region's Gold Medal fishing waters and find a secluded spot to drop a line.

AUTUMN IN WESTERN FREMONT COUNTY:

Fishing in the region is best in the autumn, when caddis flies are plentiful.

ATV / OHV USE

For those looking to find OHV and ATV trails, the area's public land access is fantastic. Find maps and suggestions in town at the BLM's Royal Gorge Field Office. Miles of trails suitable for motorized fun exist in western Fremont County's beautiful backcountry.

GOLD PANNING AND SIGHT-SEEING

It is a 60-mile (97km) drive from Cañon City to Salida, just a few miles beyond Fremont County's western boundary. Motorists will enjoy breathtaking, river canyon scenery, towering cliffs, rock pinnacles, and high mountain peaks; and may even spot a Rocky Mountain big horn sheep along the roadside. Pick up the Fremont County Heritage Tours self-guided booklets for Western Fremont County, or Historic Howard, available at www.fremontheritage.com, or from visitor centers.

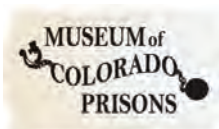

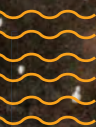
